## FACTS ABOUT URINE IN YOUR CARPET

- As soon as a pet urinates on the carpet, the warm acidic liquid immediately becomes a breeding ground for bacteria.
- The acidic urine begins to oxidize on the carpet fibers creating a color change, which can often be permanent.
- The urine spreads and gravitates down into the pad and sub-floor. It is important to determine where it has spread.
- Once urine begins to dry, the moisture evaporates and microscopic salts and crystals are formed. These urine crystals remain in your carpet, pad and floor.
- Urine smells last for years in carpet. In order to eliminate the odor, the crystal and salt deposits must be permanently deactivated.
- The crystals and salts react to humidity in the air. Any humidity level changes cause the crystals and salts to give off a heavier urine smell. This often occurs in the summer when it is humid and in the winter when the home heater is on.
- Male animals urinate around the perimeters and females urinate in open areas. Both often repeat urination in the same areas.
- Determining the total amount of urine in the carpet is critical in order to ensure the Pet Treatment Procedure is effective.
